If you are applying for COX NC1 certificate please ensure you complete the Coastal Navigation enrolment when you submit your initial COX enrolment so that training CD, Chart, etc can be sent to you with your training manual.

Complete Marine Radio enrolment and study so that Exam Papers can be ordered.

This study plan is a guide only. You can work as hard or as little as you. What this plan shows you is that if you commit just a couple of hours a night the assignments can be completed in less than 4 weeks. Set you own goals and objectives. The process is much easier if you can at least establish a plan that allows you to study every day. Your study plan will be much harder if you study just a day here and there. Consistency is required.

You should aim to complete the pre study activities at least 14 days prior to the course 'practical' session. These final 14 days are for the submission of your rope work video, course 'Project' and Marine Radio. For NC1 Coxswain only coastal navigation should also be completed during this period.

The 'Project' carries a 10% assessment weighting for General Purpose Hands and a 20% assessment weighting for Coxswains' NC2 and NC1.
